Notice of Time of Use Rates

Stowe Electric Department ("SED") filed revised and new time of use rates ("TOU") for approval with the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("PUC") on August 18, 2025, under case number 25-1792-TF. The TOU rates will be available October 1, 2025, for residential, small commercial, and commercial demand customers as opt-in voluntary rates.

SED's power supply costs are reduced during off-peak periods. The TOU rates provide an opportunity for customers to take advantage of cheaper off-peak time periods to power flexible electric loads, including electric vehicle charging and electric washers and dryers.

Time Of Use Residential Rate 03 is revised and offered as an alternative to Residential Rate 01. Time Of Use Small Commercial Rate 21 is new and offered as an alternative to Small Commercial Rate 20. Time Of Use Large Commercial Demand Rate 26 is new and offered as an alternative to Large Commercial Demand Rate 25.
