

**APPENDIX A TO POLE ATTACHMENT TARIFF**  
**TOWN OF STOWE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT**

**Rates for Pole Attachments According to Vermont Public Utility Commission Rule 3.700**

Applicability:

All entities seeking to attach lines, wires, cables, or other facilities to a pole owned by Stowe Electric Department (SED). The terms and conditions of this tariff supersede all existing contractual terms and apply to all attachments existing prior to or made after October 01, 2020.

Rate and Charges:

Pursuant to the updated Vermont Public Utility Commission Rule 3.706, on October 01, 2020 Stowe Electric Department will apply a single pole rental rate. This rental rate will apply the presumptive values of 1.25 feet for Space Occupied by Attachment, and 16 feet for total usable space. In the event SED completes a study of its pole infrastructure, it will update these values based on the space actually occupied by a particular attachment and average pole height. SED does not currently have any jointly owned poles.

Licensors reserves all rights pursuant to Board Rule 3.706(D)(1)(a) with respect to attachments not fitting within the assumed rates set forth above and calculated in accordance with Rule 3.706(C).

Terms and Conditions:

Attachment fees are payable semiannually on March 31 for the period January 1 through June 30; and September 30 for the period July 1 through December 31. Fees are calculated on the number of attachments authorized on the first day of the applicable six-month period.

All fees and charges are due and payable 30 days after presentation of a bill. Late payments will be assessed a late payment of 1% per month on all unpaid balance, commencing 30 days after the date due and payable.

Terms and condition specific to attachment of facilities are contained in Section POLE.ATT of the Town of Stowe Electric Department Service Rules and Regulations.
