Historic Moscow Mill Building An Upcoming Restoration Project



The Moscow Mill building, now owned by Stowe Electric Department, is on the National Register of Historic Places. This October, Stowe Electric started a project to stabilize the building while we work with partners on granting funding to restore the building.

The Mill, built c.1823, sits on an intact 6-foot thick fieldstone foundation with 3-historically significant stone archways. The dam, built c.1822, was a timber-crib structure that was encased in concrete in 1918. The dam and mill were built to provide waterpower to drive saw and grist milling operations. In the 20th century, the mill produced electricity for the Village of Stowe and the hydroelectric plant remained operational until a storm surge from Tropical Storm Irene damaged the facility. Stowe Electric is working with the Preservation Trust of Vermont, University of Vermont, the Stowe Historical Society, the Lamoille County Planning Commission, and others to develop a restoration plan.

Sign Up For Autopay Today!

If you are tired of writing checks or remembering your due date, you can now sign up for autopay on our website and also our Stowe Electric App.

Step 1 – Log in to your customer account on our app or via our website.

** If you don't already have a customer account, create one by clicking "Create an account". You will need your electric account number, latest bill amount, and the phone number we have listed on your account. Call our office if you do not have this information available to you.*

Step 2 – Click on your service address.

Step 3 – Click "Payment Drafts".

Step 4 – Select either "Credit Card Draft" or "Bank Draft" and enter the details.
